* Conference topics

Austrian-Slovenian Intelligent Tourist-Information Center project (AS-IT-IC project) was approved in the Cooperation Programme Interreg V-A Slovenia-Austria in the period 2014-2020. The main project output will be the operational center with humans involved, having support of the following tools: Virtual assistant (providing automatic answering in natural language to the questions and performing services) according to demands from tourists, Communication service (ICT solution that will enable conversation between the tourists, virtual assistants, tourist information workers and local communities), Information sources (inclusion of existing information sources), Recommender system for tour planning, Network of tourist services and services from local communities.

At the Workshop the main concepts and prototypes, developed within the project so far, will be presented. Additionally, cooperation options with general public and tourist information and services providers will be discussed and identified. General public and stakeholders interested in innovative and intelligent ICT solutions that empower tourists and tourist workers are invited to the workshop.

The authors should submit papers by email to jernej.zupancic@ijs.si. Acceptable formats are MS Word (recommended) and LaTeX. The papers will be reviewed by the members of the Programme Committee. The accepted papers will be published in the conference proceedings.

The accepted papers will be presented at the Workshop. By default, the presentations will be given in English and can include the demo of the presented system. Time allocated for each presentation will be approximately 15 minutes.
